What is a Neighbourhood Plan?

A Neighbourhood Plan is a document that sets out the direction of growth of a specific area from implementation until 2030.

The purpose is to ensure that any future developments within that area are meaningful to the community and in the interest of residents. The document itself will be used by planning officers at Cheshire East Council to determine what happens with planning applications and it will become part of the statutory development plan, alongside Cheshire East's Local Plan.

The document cannot stop all future developments from taking place, but it should ensure that contributions

towards infrastructure, facilities and services are in the best interests of the community, as well as conforming with local and national planning policies.

As a resident in the community, the plan gives you the opportunity to have input on use of land in that area – the local history and character, its landscape, type and tenure of development, where development should go and how it can benefit residents and community.

What could the plan achieve?

- 1 Set a direction for any future planning
- 2 Take control over land use, preserving local history and character
- 3 Ensure future development benefits the community and the residents within it


